As a result of this most unfortunate drought situation, we are working out the logistics of moving mooring lines, marinas, and an undetermined number of houseboats to dry land. One of the moves will be that of taking McClure Point Marina farther out into the lake. To that end, we will begin removing the restrooms, store, fuel barges, and septic barge beginning May 27th, 2014 – the Tuesday after Memorial Day. When the restrooms are removed there will no longer be water to the dock and you will need to use your houseboat pumps for wash-down purposes. As the marina moves out even farther, we will need to disconnect the power. You will be further informed in advance of that happening in enough time to remove any food that would spoil in the absence of electricity.

We appreciate your understanding during this process and we assure you that everything we are doing, and time frame involved, is absolutely necessary to best address the daily-falling lake elevation to what will be historic low levels and its effect on the mooring/marina infrastructure.
